UNIFORM GUIDELINES

The emphasis is always on neatness and good grooming. Students are expected to adhere to *the College expectations with regards to:*

All students are expected to have the correct full College uniform and to take pride in it. A good personal and public image is important and this should be promoted at all times. Students are to show their respect for the College by wearing their uniform properly at all times. This applies from the time they leave home in the morning until the time they return home at the end of the day.

Summer Uniform

- Trinity Dress (length to be mid knee when standing, and the side tabs done up)
- Trinity Shirt
- Trinity Navy Shorts/Dress Shorts
- Trinity Skort
- Trinity Long pants/Slacks (not rolled up)
- Short or Long Navy Trinity Socks
- Trinity Hat/Cap
- Formal black leather covered polishable shoes – Not Vans; Converse; casual black canvas, high tops, slip-on shoes.
- Trinity Jumper / Vest or Sport Zip Jacket may be worn during inclement summer weather or Year 12 Jersey
- When students are wearing shorts and untucked shirt, no tie is required. If wearing a tie, a belt must be worn and shirt tucked in.
- When students are wearing long pants, shirt must be tucked in, belt must be worn.
- Trinity hat/cap is encouraged to be worn all year round but must be worn during Term 1 and Term 4 for sport, PE and oval activities during lunchtime.

Winter Uniform

- Trinity Dress (length to be mid knee when standing and side tabs done up) and Trinity stockings
- Trinity Shirt
- Trinity Long pants/slacks (not rolled up)
- Short or Long Navy Trinity Socks
- Formal black leather covered polishable shoes – Not Vans; Converse; casual black canvas, high tops, slip-on shoes.
- Black Dress belt
- Trinity Blazer
- When students are wearing long pants the shirt must be tucked in, and the Trinity tie and belt worn.

Optional Accessories

- Trinity socks may be worn with stockings.
- College Scarf or plain black or navy blue scarf

- Trinity Jumper / Vest or Year 12 Jersey may be worn under Blazer for extra warmth
- Year 12 Jerseys and Sport Zip Jackets are permitted to be worn each day other than at formal Assemblies, formal functions or College Mass.
- Blue or black hair tie.

Sports Uniform - Wednesdays and PE days (Black Leather shoes must be brought to school and worn in TAS classes on these days)

- Trinity Sports Shorts
- Trinity Polo Shirt
- White Trinity Socks/Short White Socks
- Supportive ankle and arched purposed sport shoes (eg joggers) no casual, Converse, Vans or skate shoes.
- Trinity hat/cap is to be worn during Term 1 and Term 4 for sport, PE and oval activities during lunch time.

Optional Accessories

- College Track Pants
- College Track Jacket
- Trinity Jumper / Vest or Year 12 Jersey may be worn

Haircuts / styles - the emphasis is always on neatness and good grooming

- Hair is to be clean, neat and tidy - no extreme hair styles.
- Hair to be no shorter than a number 2 cut.
- Facial hair, including sideburns which extend below bottom of earlobe and 'goatees' are not permissible.
- Dyes and rinses should be restricted to natural hair colours - other colours not accepted.
- Long hair must be tied back in practical subjects or where a WHS issue has been identified by a staff member.

Jewellery

Please be advised that to reduce the risk of WHS issues students are permitted to only wear

- One plain ring.
- Thin gold or silver plain chain or with a cross around their necks.
- A single earring of either a plain gold or silver sleeper/ plain gold or silver stud or one set of either plain gold or silver sleepers or plain gold or silver studs in ear lobes and only one cartilage earring may be worn. Hoop or dangly earrings are not permitted as they pose a WHS risk.
- A plain silver or gold bracelet.
- No other type of jewellery is permissible.
- Any other body art (tattoos) or body piercing requiring studs or sleepers which are visible while wearing the College uniform are NOT permitted.
- Wrist watch

Make Up

Light discreet makeup is permissible to cover skin blemishes and only clear fingernail polish is to be worn.

Purchase of the Uniform

The College uniform is only available from the Uniform Shop at the College which is managed by the Ranier Design Group.

Staff Action

Uniform will be monitored by all teachers (especially during tutor time) and any breach must be corrected immediately and documented in the student's planner. If any further issues arise a referral must be made to the Head of House and Assistant Principal Students and Staff for parental contact to be made and a directive given to correct the breach. The final decision regarding uniform rests with the Assistant Principals.

Casual Dress Standards

On very few occasions students will be given permission to wear Casual Dress for College activities and functions. All casual clothing is to be appropriate and modest and to meet the standards provided below:

- Covered footwear only to be worn
- No sleeveless shirts, singlets or tank tops
- No halter tops
- No see through clothing
- No strapless or shoestring tops or dresses
- No mid-rift to be showing
- No miniskirts or micros-shorts
- No cleavage to be showing
- No underwear to be visible
- Graphics on clothing must be appropriate
